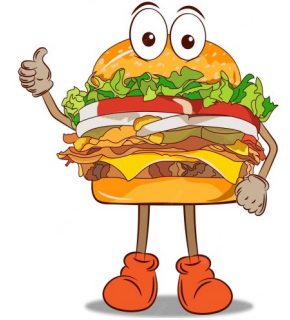

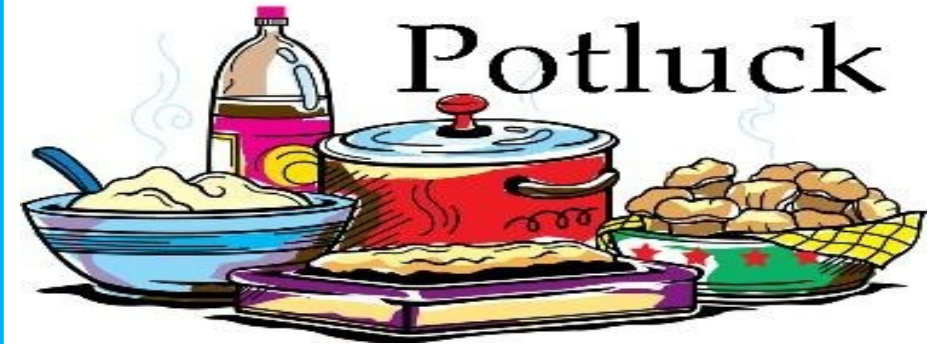

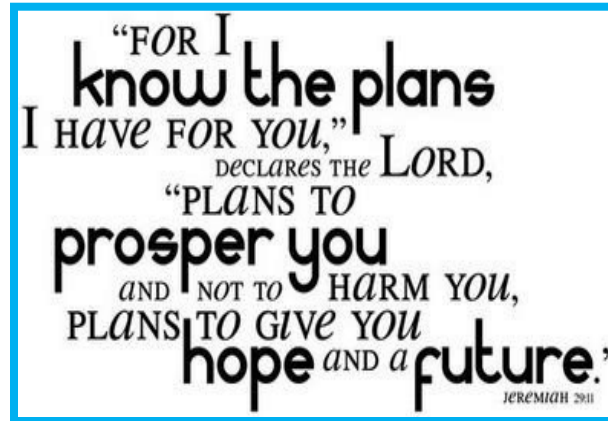

If you don't have children, don't assume you won't get anything out of the class, because a study in temperaments will also help us better understand how two brothers, (Jacob and Esau, or Cain and Abel), can be raised by the same parents, and yet have totally different outcomes. So, you can prepare yourself by reading Genesis 25:27-34, as well as Hebrews 12, focusing on verses 12-17. Also, don't forget that our question sheet for each week is placed in the foyer each Monday afternoon, so feel free to pick one up for your at-home studies!
