We have a lot happening at the Angleton Church of Christ, and I wanted to take a moment to remind you of a few upcoming events and how you can get involved.

This past Sunday, we had another planning meeting for our Vacation Bible School. Although it may seem early to some, starting early will help us have a more successful event. Our theme for this year's VBS is "Camp Out: Learning S'more About Jesus." We plan to hold it from June 24-27, each day from 9 am to 12 pm.

During our last planning meeting, we discussed ideas on decorating the foyer, auditorium, hallway, and classroom. We plan on using many items we already have and doing a lot of crafting ourselves.
