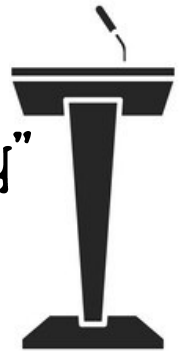

EXPRESSION OF GRATITUDE

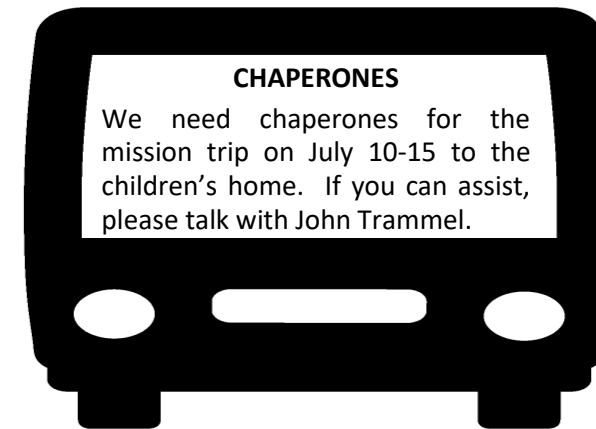
