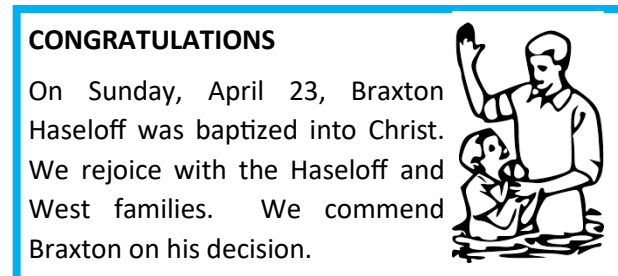
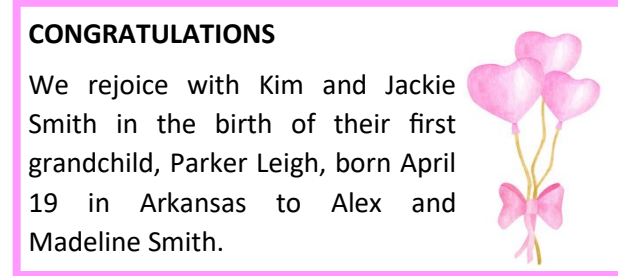
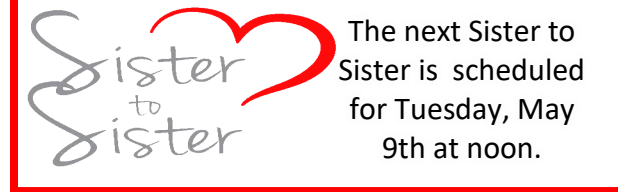
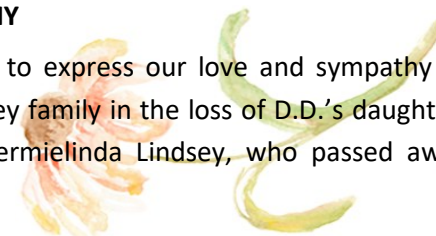


## SENDING LOVE
